Thank you for extending the time our community can stay at 3814 4th Avenue NE. As long as the State of Emergency and our health allows, we will depart by June 1, 2020.

Until then Nickelsville will maintain the Villages' property, operate in accordance with the Sanitation and Hygiene Guide for Homeless Service Providers, and allow access to Public Health, Safety, and Service Workers.

Your offer of discussion is appreciated. Top priorities will be clarifying the transition of Hygiene Facilities, and the request of Gift of Grace Church to operate our community on public land.

The coronavirus pandemic has changed Seattle forever. Lack of testing makes the extent of its impact - and the appropriate community response - still uncertain. All agree that well equipped Tiny House Villages like ours are an important way to prevent the spread of the coronavirus.

We are flexible when it comes to hygiene services. It is in everyone's interest that hot water, washers and dryers, and showers remain accessible and stable on site. This will require cooperation and communication.
